

Great leaders are born young and few can exemplify this better than B. S. Abdur Rahman, the Founder of Thassim Beevi Abdul Kader College for Women. A lad of barely nine or 10, he showed the first signs of being a visionary with a mission when he went around Kilakarai, his native village in Tamil Nadu of India, along with friends, urging non-school going children to attend school. Even as a boy, he has wondered why schools of international standard were so few in rural India. He was determined to do something about it. Wordly- wise and practical, he drew his lessons in life. According to him, it is hard to make money and harder to keep it. But it's the hardest to utilize it for the right purpose. With vision and enterprise, he established various businesses but he utilized his energies to build charitable institutions. He believed education was the key to empowerment. He had denied himself higher education in his quest for riches but he compensated it in plenty by offering education to others. With a missionary zeal almost, he set up a number of educational institutions, making special efforts to uplift the downtrodden sections of society, particularly women. Muslim girls had to stop their studies with school education due to lack of tertiary level institutions for girls in his native town. Thassim Beevi Abdul Kader College for Women, Kilakarai was established in 1988 with residential facilities for girls not only in Ramanathapuram District but also from the surrounding Districts. The institution has attracted girl students from neighboring countries also [e.g. Ceylon, Malaysia, Thailand and Sudan. The torchbearer for multitudes of beneficiaries from the down – trodden sector is the peerless Alhaj B S Abdur Rahman. Service, motivation, commitment, broad outlook, relentless aspiration, a thirst for venture and knowledge are a few of the efficacies in his journey into charity. 

Our college library was established in the year 1988 with just 600 books to its credit. It has grown into a separate magnificent three-storied building almost in the centre of the campus occupying a carpet area of 7,347 sq.ft. named Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Central Library in 2015. The Library has about 29,144 books and more than 212 periodicals including National and International Journals. The library has innovative infrastructure facilities with modern technology. Since 2011, the library has been partially automated with all its subsystems. At present, "AUTOLIB" - version 7.2 Integrated Library Management Software on Windows and Linux Enterprise platforms, with 1 server and 74 clients attached to it. Dspace, an institutional repository is available with Wi-Fi connections. The library system includes central and departmental libraries. Each department has their own compact library in which relevant books are kept to cater to the immediate reference of faculty members and students.































E-Library Facility with 70 terminals are provided with internet facility in a centrally Air-Conditioned hall in the second floor. An OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) has been created and it is also made available via LAN in the campus. The Department of Computer Science was established in 1988 and it has become the Approved Research Center of Alagappa University in the year 2011. We offer several Certificate Programmes in Web Designing, Design and Drafting and PC Assembly. We also offer Summer Crash Course in Office Automation Lab, Web Designing Lab and PC Assembly & Installation from 2022-23 onwards. Our department conducts various interdepartmental intra-departmental competitions to promote the students' technical, analytical and reasoning skills. Our department has Memorandum of Understanding with International Skill Development Corporation (ISDC), UK, and London for value-added programs such as Business Analytics / Data Analytics, KwaZulu-Natal University, Pietermarit Zburg, South Africa and Winways, Madurai.

CHEMISTRY

The Department was established to offer allied courses to the students of Home Science during 1988. The Department was upgraded to offer UG Program in Chemistry during 2005 with well qualified faculty members and laboratory facilities. To produce skilled human resource to society, value added courses like waste water treatment was introduced as a certificate programme in the year 2008. Our undergraduate students carried out academic projects that helped the Department to focus on phytochemical based research for nanoparticle synthesis, bio lubricants, biofilms and adsorbents in water purifications. In the year 2018, Department offered its postgraduate programme in M.Sc. Chemistry. The alumnae of the Department occupy pivotal position in colleges, school teachers, industries, pharmaceuticals and researchers. Our department has signed MoUs with various Industries and Institutions - Aquaagri, NIIT, BARC, Thermal Power plant (Thoothukudi) and West Bengal University of animals & fishery science. These initiatives help our Department in taking up consultancy projects, collaborative academic research, internship training and student projects. Our post graduate student project was selected for financial support by TNSCST to carry out their research. Our Department Head received Young Scientist Award 2022 from Research Culture Society, Thailand. The department of Chemistry offer skill based certificate programme in Dairy Chemistry and certificate programme in Aromatherapy and Cosmetics to encourage students to have entrepreneurial start-ups.

Department also offers certificate courses like Mushroom Cultivation, Bio Fertilizer Production, Vermicomposting Process and Sustainable Aquaculture for the students to improve their skills in entrepreneurship development. The Best innovative practices of the department include Micro-Doc, NET-Coaching, Placement training programs etc. Additionally, the department is also engaged in maintaining Departmental garden-OXYZONE (having flowering and medicinal plants) along with a herbal garden which includes plants having marvelous properties like anxiolytic and anti-depressant, anti-inflammation, anti-aging, acne treating, saponins, salicylic acids and amino acids etc. Faculty members of the department are having various projects funded by TNSCST (Tamilnadu state council for Science and Technology). Research papers are being published in peer-reviewed journals by the faculty members of the department. Guest lectures are regularly held by inviting distinguished academicians from various renowned academic institutions. The department encourages the students to establish new methodologies and encourages innovative ideas to have start-ups.






RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT CELL (RDC)


