Assalamu alaikum.. Greetings to all of you!!

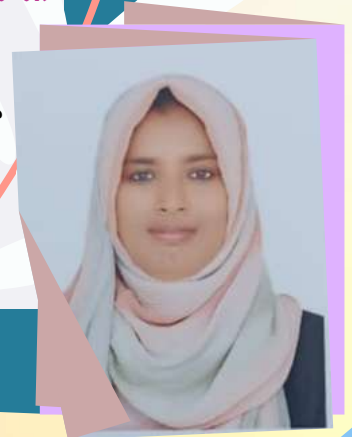

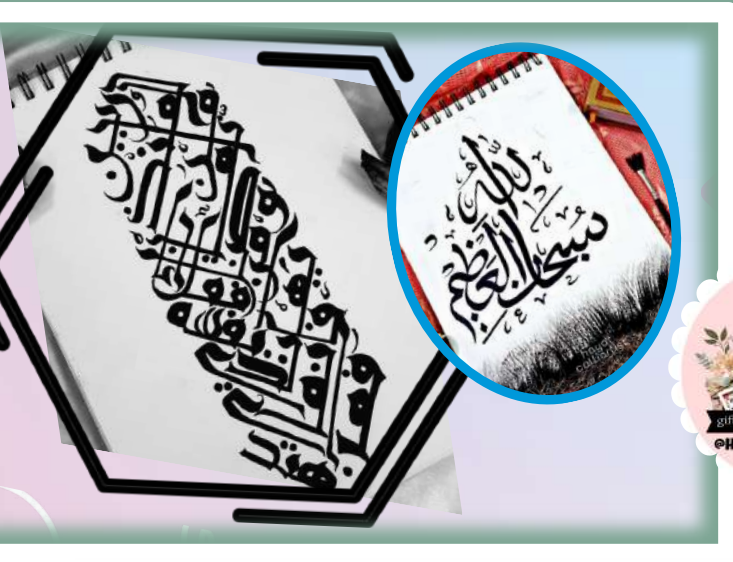

I always wanted to work in the service field to make lives better for other human beings. After my dream of learning medicine failed, I arrived to TBAKC as a clueless NRI student in 2015 and chose Microbiology as it was the closest to what I wanted. The journey through TBAK was a sharp learning curve and I grew as a person. I toughened up and learned to put myself first. I complete my Masters in the same field in BSA crescent University, the sister university of TBAK. The unexpected pandemic was felt like fullstop to my education & my dreams of a career as the whole world came to a stop. I made sure to grab that opportunity of emerging digital classes. I put my love for the English language & my competency and secured a job as an English facilitator for an online learning platform. It came with its own challenges, unstable internet connection in Kilakarai, frequent power cuts and of course dealing with people who always try to pull you down. That made me feel terrible, but I refused to succumb to the egos of the patriarchy & pushed through it by the grace of God. It was one of my first steps into the career world.

I got married and landed in a strange country where everybody around you is of a skin colour that's assumed to be superior and always being stared at for wearing my hijab. I wanted to work, but it was impossible to get a job unless you are fluent in the local language. I had to go through multiple levels of authorisations to get an approval for my education from India and it was brought to my knowledge that I had to study again to get authorised. I was demotivated and it was one obstacle after the other. But by the grace of God I was willed and determined to learn the language instead of whining about my challenges.

During my learning phase I came across a non profit organisation where there was a requirement for teachers to teach spoken English to refugees. To my surprise they told me that they would rather have a teacher who loves the language & speaks it well and would enable someone else to speak. I was happy and accepted their offer to be a volunteer. I was in a room with 20 adults, who speak their own mother tongues and a little bit of the local language. I was blank, i didn't know how to explain things apart from using pictures and body language. But it was this very challenge that made me want to learn the local language. A year and a half has passed by, I am now certified at a C1 level proficiency in the language, work at a managerial level as coordinator for volunteers. & activities in the organisation. My work entails working with refugees, catering to their needs, helping them with English & teaching them to use electronic devices and safe internet browsing, visiting refugee camps, organising & conducting activities for them etc. In addition, I coordinate a team of 25-30 volunteers twice a month towards the packing and distribution of food supplies & monthly rations to over 450 families who are in need of food and in the poverty level. The same organisation also runs another branch in Sierra Leone, West Africa where we arrange sponsors for over 50 orphaned children to cover the expenses of their basic amenities, food, health and educational needs. I am in charge of sending quarterly reports about the updates about these children to their respective sponsors.

The journey hasn't been smooth, there have been bumps, crashes, obstacles & difficult situations. People's snarky comments, degrading & demotivating talks only add to the pile. But at every step, I remember my creator, thank Him for what I have, thank him for protection from evil & constantly seek forgiveness for all my known and unknown mistakes. The goal was to serve, now I do serve, but not in the way that I had planned, but in the way in which it was pre-planned for me. The proverb that "Man proposes, God disposes" is nothing but true. I've never been someone who gives out advice, but to the reader who feels like their life has come to a full block, believe me when I say it gets better. It may take time, a lot of time, sometimes years, but it does get better and when you look back, you'll be grateful for the experiences. Have faith and trust in God's plans and seek protection from evil.
