As a part of Collaborative MoU Activity with English Language Teachers' Association, Chennai, the Department of English as a Ramanathapuram ELTAI Chapter – Student Wing - conducts “**LangEx- Language Skills Competition**” for the students of all disciplines to identify the “Language Expert” , who is marvelled at all the four skills (LSRW) – Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing Skills and also to make the students identify their LSRW skills competency by setting benchmarks and to judge the lacunae for further enhancement.

It is a 4-skills Testing Competition, comprising of four sessions of Competitions namely Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing accordingly the criteria set, through which analyse the students' language acquisition & proficiency level and based on the score of the students' performance in the four Skills tests, the toppers are identified and among them, the only one who has got excelled at all the four skills deserve to be titled as the “Language Expert” of the year.

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
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## DEPARTMENT OF FASHION DESIGNING

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
