Blended Education via Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs).

Objective of the Practice

Integrating MOOC principles, this initiative allows students to earn 20% program credits through open-access online courses, fostering accessibility, leveraging top-tier faculty, and addressing digital disparities in India.

The Context

SWAYAM (MOOCs) at TBAKC aims to uncover student learning paths through smart education, extending accessibility beyond classrooms. The College Departmental MOOCs Coordinator collaborates with course coordinators and teachers, fostering a dynamic teacher-student interaction to facilitate effective and time-bound learning.

The Practice

TBAKC provides Blended Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs), where a designated MOOCs Coordinator from the college assigns a faculty member to the MOOCs course selected by students.

The assigned faculty conducts a weekly session to address student queries related to the course, monitor their progress, and ensure compliance with assignment submissions and other course requirements.

The program regulations afford students flexibility in earning up to 20% of their credits by allowing them to choose courses from various MOOCs.

Evidence of Success

The enrolment in MOOCs has shown a gradual increase. From June to December 2022, a total of 1146 students participated in spoken tutorial (MOOCs), with 320 students successfully earning certification.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

There is a need to offer unpaid courses and certifications offered on MOOCs to provide students with a broader selection of courses aligned with their interests. Additionally, enhancing the options for selecting examination centers would contribute to greater accessibility for students

Evidence of Success:




Problems Encountered and Resources Required:




