Assalammu Alaikkum (Warah)! My warm greetings and a very cheerful good morning to one and all present here for the 34th academic day celebrations.

The 2020 pandemic has brought with it both challenges and impacts in the education system. Despite this inevitable catastrophe, I am glad to share that we have completed the academic year 2021-22 successfully amidst the unprecedented crisis.

I deem it my splendid privilege to utilize this opportunity to present a brief Academic Report of our exemplary Institution of eminence for the Academic year 2021-22 before this august assembly.

The year 2021-22 was exemplified with a series of achievements towards academic, research, placement and students' curricular & co curricular activities. All these endeavours commenced with the resourceful mind of our Founder, B.S. Abdur Rahman who laid a firm foundation for the institution with the vision to empower women by providing quality higher education. In order to transform our Founder's dream into goal, Thassim Beevi Abdul Kader College for Women strives hard to empower women and competes with the current research innovations and concurrent academic challenges to reach the Zenith of higher education. The luminosity of our Founder's dream is sustained by bringing more and more laurels and adding many accolades to our college. Our college is second to none in the quality of its faculty, programmes, and research & innovation activities. These achievements would not be brought into picture without the adequate infrastructure. So let me commence the highlights of this academic year with Infrastructure and learning resources.

Infrastructure and Learning Resources

The college ensures adequate availability of physical infrastructure and maintains the best learning ambiance in the campus.

- TBAKC had its humble beginning with a single academic block comprising 65 students and a total of 11 faculties on 29th July 1988. The college, over the four decades, has recorded phenomenal growth in terms of infrastructure, research & innovation, entrepreneurship and placement. At present, the College has 3 academic blocks and 67 classrooms in which 22 are Smart Board enabled classrooms. The internal stakeholders are 1654 students, 100 faculty members, 79 non-teaching and 10 technical staff. Among them 3 have Post doctoral degree, 19 have doctoral degree and 36 faculties have M.Phil degree, 6 faculties have cleared SET and 5 have cleared NET. Also 8 faculties are pursuing Ph D. Now the institution has become a full-fledged educational and research institution offering 17 UG programmes, 10 PG programmes, 5 M Phil and 3 Doctoral programmes in various disciplines.
- Total Number of students enrolled in the academic year 2021-22 is 635, in UG level 522 students, in PG level 111 students, in M.Phil 1 and in Ph D 2 scholars. New admission strategies were formed by upgrading the digital platform and SEO so that the number of admission scaled up from 525 to 635 with more than a 12 percent increase in the current academic year after COVID 19 Pandemic.
- We have a administrative block, 3 academic blocks, 1 library, 1 lecture hall, 1 conference hall, 1 well equipped auditorium with 750 seating, 1 Masjid and 1 hostel block.
- We have spacious classrooms with 616 ICT gadgets and well-equipped laboratories with an internet facility of 200 mbps bandwidth.
- Business Lab, Mathematics Lab, Food Processing Lab/Incubation Centre, Research Lab (Computer Science) and Communicative Skills Centre (English) reflect our continued commitment to upscale the infrastructure.
- Our library has a buildup area of 7347 sq.ft with three floors. It is a well-equipped air conditioned DIGITAL and central library. We have subscribed 86 National Journals, 48 International Journals, 78 Magazines and 212 Periodicals. The library is furnished with 74 systems and we use more than 3,00,000 titles of e-journals and e-books from DELNET, N-List & 7000 titles from D Space Software. The library has recently integrated with the Central Library of the B.S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of

Science and Technology, agreeing to access each other's library and other digital resources.

- The Department of Chemistry inaugurated Diary Chemistry Lab on 10.01.2022.
- The institution has been recognized as Centre of Excellence for Women Empowerment to train women students on Advanced IT Skills under Honeywell Student Empowerment Program.
- The adequate infrastructure and learning resources enhance teaching and learning process.

Teaching, Learning and Evaluation

- During this academic year, 42 faculty members have been appointed as Assistant Professors with 5 Doctorates and 3 Post Doctorates on a pan India level.
- The performance of our students in the End Semester Examinations of November 2021 is consistently good. The overall pass percentage of UG level in I semester is 94.47%, III semester is 95.28%, V semester is 91.51%. In PG level the pass percentage in I semester is 99.08%, in III semester is 98.11%, and in V semester is 50%. Overall pass percentage has been increased comparing to the previous academic year.
- TBAKCW offers opportunities and resources to faculty for their professional growth. A cohort of faculty members attended international level, national level and state level webinars, FDP, seminars, workshops, training programme, refresher courses and Conferences to update themselves in their own discipline during 2021-22.

Curricular Aspects

Following are the major highlights of the academic activities held during 2021-22

- The new UG Programmes such as BCA, B Sc Cyber Security and B Com Professional Accounting was introduced.
- Semester wise action plan is carried out by each department.
- Board of Studies Meeting was convened virtually for all the Departments. The Department of Arabic, English, Commerce, Computer Science and Chemistry on 27.01.2022 & the Department of Hindi, Home Science, Mathematics, Microbiology, Psychology and Tamil on 28.01.2022 for complete revamping of syllabus with OBE concepts.

- New API format was circulated to the entire faculty to assess their performance in academic and research.

18th Academic Council Meeting was held on 14.05.2022 for the approval of revised syllabus with OBE concepts. Research & Development Cell Activities

To integrate the Research, Innovation and Technology Development at TBAKCW, as per the UGC guidelines the Research and Development Cell (RDC) is established to enable the attainment of targets in global level and to play a pivotal role in catalyzing multidisciplinary/transdisciplinary and translational research culture.

- The Research and Development Cell provides policy guidelines and direction for the growth and development of research activities. Dr Irfan Ahmed, the Director for Research & Industry-Institute Relations was appointed in March 2021.
- Our faculty members have published 43 research papers in major UGC-listed research journals (Refer Annexure). A total of 24 research proposals submitted to various funding agencies. Among them 3 Student Research Projects are accepted during 2021-22 by TNSCST and received the approval with a research grant of Rs.7500 for each project.
